

ORDINANCE 86 - 9

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A "REFERENDUM" TO BE HELD FOR THE PURPOSE OF VOTING ON SUNDAY SALES OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHIN THE CITY OF SKY VALLEY, GEORGIA:

WHEREAS, the City Council has been requested to allow the qualified voters of the City to decide whether or not to permit and regulate the sale of alcoholic beverages by the drink on Sundays;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained that the Election Superintendent of the City hold and supervise such an election on December 2, 1986, the date of the election for two (2) members of the City Council, and make known the results of such election as provided by law.
